

Interview Ideas – Please customize to suit your child!

Tip – Try to make as many questions open-ended as possible. Yes or No answers aren't as rich and descriptive as giving the child a way to start a longer dialogue.

- What is your name?
- How old are you?
- What grade are you in?
- What school do you go to?
- Who is your best friend?
- What are your hobbies?
- What is the best thing that happened to you this year?
- How about the worst thing?
- What are you most excited about this year?
- What do you want to be when you grow up?

Tip – Try to record any distinguishing physical marks (birth marks, scars, etc.) that set your child apart.
